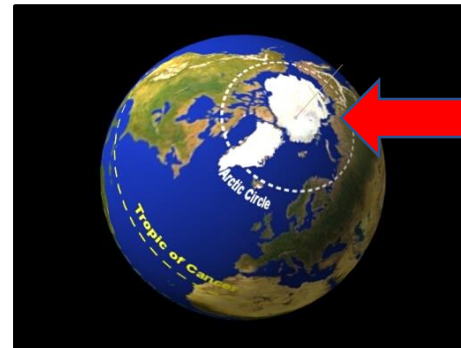

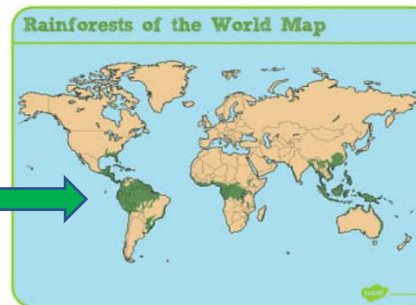
Key Vocabulary
