## Printing

### Sticky Knowledge

- A printing block can be made from different materials and reused to produce a piece of wallpaper.
- Printing patterns can be full drop, half drop or random
- Hot colours are red, yellow, orange and brown
- Cold colours are blue, green and purple
- We enhance the colour and depth by using difference colours.
