Key vocabulary

Collaboratively/ Cooperation/ Teamwork – two or more people working together to complete a task.

Map – diagram representing an area of land.

Key – box on a map showing what the different symbols on a map represent.

Compass – instrument that shows cardinal points north, east, south and west.

Navigating – use maps and compasses to plan and move to a pre-set destination.

Orient – using landmarks and compasses to align and position a map so it can be used to navigate correctly.

Orienteering – participants navigate an area using a map and a compass.

Sticky Knowledge

Reading maps helps humans to find places.
