Magritte is most famous for his surrealist style artwork.

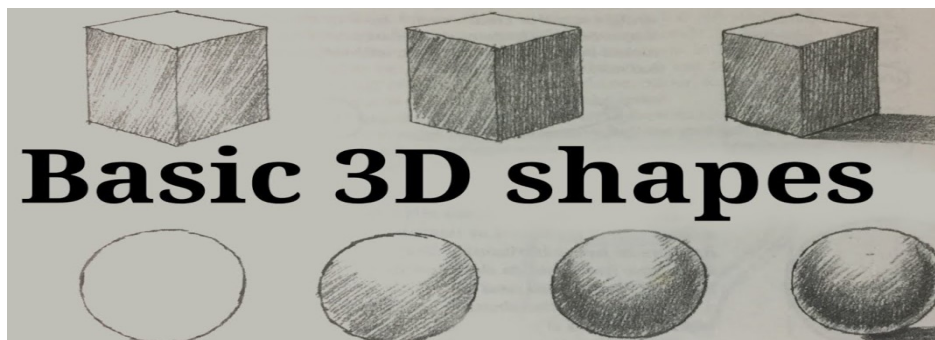
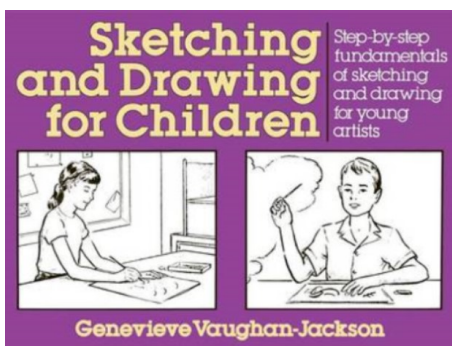
