Symbolism	A form of art where a n image has a deeper meaning.

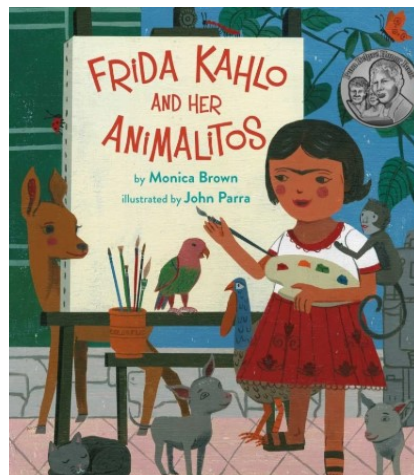


Sticky Knowledge
