Vincent Van Gogh	the Dutch painter who created Sunflowers.
Sunflowers	a tall North American plant of the daisy family, with very large golden-rayed flowers. Sunflowers are cultivated for their edible seeds, which are an important source of oil for cooking and margarine.
Tone	how dark or light something is
Texture	how something feels or how you'd imagine it feels
Layered	when the same or different medium are used to create an effect.

Sticky Knowledge

Vincent van Gogh was a famous Dutch painter who was born in the Netherlands. He created about 2100 pieces of art.

Primary colours are red, blue and yellow.

Mixing primary colours will produce secondary colours.

Secondary colours are purple, green and orange.

Mixing with black or white will produce colour hues (lighter and darker shades of colours).

Different tools (like brushes) and materials (like sand, sawdust and glue) can help to create various paint textures and effects.
