Dear Parents and Carers,

It was lovely to welcome our children and families back into school on Monday after a lovely half term break. I hope you all enjoyed the warm weather.

Year 6 have been busy learning their lines in preparation for their end of year production of "The Keymaster" which will be performed on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July at 1:30pm and then the evening of Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July at 6:00pm.
